Except as explained in the following paragraph, I (we) conducted my (our) audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Canadian generally accepted auditing standards require that I (we) plan and perform an audit to obtain reasonable assurance whether the financial information is free of material misstatement. An audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by the CFO, as well as evaluating the overall financial statement presentation.
