## REMOVAL ON BEHALF OF A DECEASED ELECTOR FROM THE PERMANENT REGISTER OF ELECTORS FOR ONTARIO

To apply for removal from the Permanent Register of Electors for Ontario on behalf of a deceased elector, please complete the attached '*Application for Removal of a Deceased Elector from the Permanent Register of Electors for Ontario*' form and submit it with a copy of the deceased elector's Death Certificate or any other sort of written proof of death. Please see below for the list of documents that are considered acceptable as proof of death.

Please return the completed '*Removal of Deceased*' package, including the '*Application for Removal of a Deceased Elector from the Permanent Register of Electors for Ontario*' form and a copy of the required proof of death documentation. ## Identification requirements for Removal on Behalf of a Deceased Elector from the Permanent Register of Electors for Ontario

To apply on behalf of a deceased elector for removal from the permanent register of electors, the applicant must show proof of death that is acceptable to the standard set out by the CEO.

- You may use one of the documents from **List A**, below, to meet this requirement

### List A: Identification showing Proof of Death

- A burial or death certificate
- An obituary from a newspaper
- A document/receipt issued by a cemetery/crematorium in Ontario that proves burial or cremation
- A Life or Group Insurance Claim along with a statement signed by a medical doctor
- A Medical Certification of Death
- A Memorandum of Notification of Death issued by the Chief of the National Defence Staff
- A notarial copy of Letters of Probate
- An official notification from the Public Trustee
- A Registration of Death
- A statement of from a medical doctor, coroner, or funeral director
- A Statement of Verification of Death from the Department of Veterans Affairs
- A program or notice from a funeral ceremony
