


Candidate Nomination Paper (F0400)





General Information

Candidate Qualifications

Under the *Election Act*, every person is qualified to be a candidate who, at the time of signing the consent to nomination:

- is 18 years of age or older,
- is a Canadian citizen,
- has resided in Ontario for the six months preceding polling day, and
- is **NOT** disqualified by the *Legislative Assembly Act* or by any other Act.

To Become a Candidate

To become a candidate you must complete and submit a Candidate Nomination Paper (F0400).

You may file your **Candidate Nomination Paper (F0400)** either as a standing nomination with the Chief Electoral Officer of Ontario any time before the writ of election is issued (meaning an election is called) or to the Returning Officer of the electoral district where you want to stand for election after an election is called. You can only be a nominated candidate in one electoral district in the Province of Ontario (*EA sec. 27(1*)).

Standing Nominations (EA sec. 27.2(1))

Your Candidate Nomination Paper (F0400) may be filed with the Chief Electoral Officer (CEO) at any time before an election is called. When your nomination is accepted you will receive a Pre-Certificate of Nomination (F0402) (EA sec. 27.2(5)) from the CEO. When the writ of election is issued you will become a candidate for the particular electoral district and are deemed nominated and registered under the Election Finances Act (EFA sec. 13(3)(b)).

Scheduled (Fixed Date) General Elections (EA sec. 9.1(4)(a))

When the writ of election is issued, your **Candidate Nomination Paper (F0400)** may only be filed with the Returning Officer of the electoral district where you want to stand for election. The nomination period starts on a Wednesday when the government of the day announces an election (which is called writ day) and ends a week later on the Thursday at 2:00 P.M. local time. Prospective candidates must make an appointment with the Returning Officer to file their **Candidate Nomination Paper (F0400)**. Once the Returning Officer issues you a **Certificate of Nomination (F0403)** (EA sec. 27.1(6)) you are deemed registered under the *Election Finances Act (EFA sec. 13(3)(b))*. You can find a fixed date general election calendar at <u>elections.on.ca</u>, under Political Entities > Information for Candidates.

By-election or Unscheduled General Election (EA sec. 9.1(4)(b))

For a by-election or an unscheduled general election, the nomination period starts on a Wednesday when the government of the day announces an election (which is called writ day) and ends two weeks later on the Thursday at 2:00 P.M. local time. Prospective candidates must make an appointment with the Returning Officer to file their **Candidate Nomination Paper (F0400)**. Once the Returning Officer issues you a **Certificate of Nomination (F0403)** (EA sec. 27.1(6)) you are deemed registered under the *Election Finances Act (EFA sec. 13(3)(b))*. You can find a by-election or unscheduled general election calendar at <u>elections.on.ca</u>, under Political Entities > Information for Candidates.



Note: As a prospective candidate, you can also securely submit one piece of government-issued photo identification to help Elections Ontario headquarters (HQ) or the Returning Officer verify the information on your **Candidate Nomination Paper (F0400)**.

However, submitting government-issued photo identification is not required.

Your Responsibility as a Prospective Candidate

It is your responsibility as a prospective candidate to ensure that your **Candidate Nomination Paper (F0400)** is complete and received on time *(EA sec. 27.1(3))*.

Completion of Nomination Paper

As a prospective candidate it is your responsibility to understand your rights and responsibilities as outlined in the **Candidate's Guide (F0405)**. All documents for prospective candidates can be found at elections.on.ca, under Political Entities > Information for Candidates.

Your nomination paper must have all sections completed or it will be refused. The mandatory sections in the **Candidate Nomination Paper (F0400)** are:

- Section 1 Candidate Information
- Section 2 Appointment of Chief Financial Officer (CFO)
- Section 3 Appointment of Auditor (if applicable)
- Section 4 Place Where Records are Kept
- Section 5 Principal Officers
- Section 6 Person(s) Authorized to Accept Contributions
- Section 7 Financial Institution(s) and Signing Officer(s)
- Section 8 Endorsement of Candidate
- Section 9 Electors Consenting to Candidacy

Submitting your Candidate Nomination Paper (F0400)

You may submit your **Candidate Nomination Paper (F0400)** electronically, in person or by fax. You do not have to be present to submit it. Submitting a Standing Nomination to Elections Ontario HQ before the election starts:

Submitting your **Candidate Nomination Paper (F0400)** to the Returning Officer in the electoral district you plan to run in, on or after writ day:

• The local election office contact information will be available on the Elections Ontario website at elections.on.ca when the writ of election is issued.



Amending the Candidate Nomination Paper (F0400)

You may change the following information on your **Candidate Nomination Paper (F0400)** by completing the **Nomination Statement of Change (F0401)** form which is located at <u>elections.on.ca</u>, under Political Entities > Information for Candidates:

Withdrawal of a Candidate

Standing Nominations with the Chief Electoral Officer:

As a prospective candidate you may withdraw your Candidate Nomination Paper (F0400)
at any time before receiving your Certificate of Nomination by delivering a withdrawal
letter signed by you to the Chief Electoral Officer.

After receiving your **Certificate of Nomination**:

As the nominated candidate in an electoral district in Ontario, you must give notice and complete a Nomination Notice of Withdrawal (F0404) form if you wish to withdraw your name as a candidate for the election representing the electoral district. The Nomination Notice of Withdrawal (F0404) form can be found at elections.on.ca, under Political Entities > Information for Candidates.

Public Inspection

Your **Candidate Nomination Paper (F0400)** will be available for public inspection at the office of the Returning Officer during an electoral event and will be available at the office of the Chief Electoral Officer during regular business hours until one year after the return of the writ for the election (EA sec. 27.4).

You must also state how you would like your name to appear on the ballot. You may refer to the Candidate Name Appearance on the Ballot section in the Candidate's Guide (F0405) before completing this part of the Candidate Nomination Paper (F0400) since there are some restrictions as to how your name appears on the ballot. A ballot cannot include a title, honour, degree or other decoration.

Section 8: Endorsement of Candidate

Please note: If you are an independent candidate you do not require an endorsement.

Instructions: The **Candidate Nomination Paper (F0400)** of a prospective candidate who is being endorsed by a registered political party and who wishes the name of that political party to be printed on the ballot MUST be accompanied by a signed endorsement form/letter from the leader of the registered political party (EA sec. 27(2)(h)). The endorsement form/letter must contain the candidate's name, the registered political party name and the electoral district name where the prospective candidate is being nominated.

The registered political party named on the endorsement form/letter must match Section 1 - Part C: Candidacy Information of the Candidate Nomination Paper (F0400).

Section 9: Electors Consenting to Candidacy

Instructions: Your nomination requires the signed declaration of 25 names and addresses of electors residing in the electoral district (EA s. 27(2)(f)) in which you will be running as a candidate. It is advisable to have more than 25 names and addresses to ensure that you have obtained the required number needed to meet residency requirements.

You may photocopy the **Declaration of Electors** (on page 17) and distribute to multiple individuals who will be assisting you in collecting the names and addresses. It is acceptable to have different witnesses for each sheet of the declaration.

The witness(es) signature(s) must be completed by the individual(s) who witnessed the elector signatures. The witnesses must print their First and Last Name to certify that each elector signed the declaration.
