REMOVAL OF A DECEASED PERSON FROM THE ONTARIO REGISTER OF FUTURE VOTERS OF 16 AND 17 YEAR-OLDS

Residents of Ontario, who are 16 or 17 years of age and Canadian citizens, can be included in the Ontario Register of Future Voters established under section 17.7 (1) of Ontario's *Election Act*.

Personal information included in the Ontario Register of Future Voters is used by Elections Ontario only for electoral purposes and is not shared with other electoral stakeholders (registered political parties, candidates, or other electoral agencies).

To apply for removal from the Ontario Register of Future Voters on behalf of someone deceased, please return the completed **Application for Removal of a Deceased Person from the Ontario Register of Future Voters** form and a photocopy of the required proof of death documentation by mail to:

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Identification Requirements for Removal of a Deceased Person from the Ontario Register of Future Voters

To apply to remove a deceased person from the Ontario Register of Future Voters, the applicant must submit one piece of documentation showing proof of death. Types of identification authorized by the Chief Electoral Officer for this purpose are found below.

Examples of documentation showing proof of death:

- A Memorandum of Notification of Death issued by the Chief of Defence Staff of National Defence
- A Statement of Verification of Death from the Department of Veterans Affairs
- A notarial copy of Letters of Probate
- An official notification from the Public Trustee
- A Registration of Death
- A burial or death certificate
- A document /receipt issued by a cemetery/crematorium in Ontario that proves burial or cremation
- A Medical Certificate of Death
- A Life or Group Insurance claim along with a statement signed by a medical doctor
- A statement from a medical doctor, coroner or funeral director
- A program from a funeral ceremony
- An obituary from a newspaper
