We organize and conduct general elections and by-elections in Ontario. That means, when an election is called, Elections Ontario will be there to make voting easy for you.

- maintain election records for research and historical reference
- review, produce and stock election forms and materials
- review electoral district and polling division boundaries
- communicate with the public, media and educational institutions
