

Campaign Expense Spending Limits by Electoral District for the 2025 General Election Final Spending Limits

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** For registered candidates in the electoral districts of Algoma—Manitoulin, Kenora—Rainy River, Kiiwetinoong, Mushkegowuk—James Bay, Nickel Belt, Thunder Bay—Atikokan, Thunder Bay—Superior North, and Timiskaming—Cochrane, the amount of the joint campaign expense limit is increased by an indexed amount. The indexed amount is amended every year and is currently \$11,703.*
