

Get ready to vote in the **Hamilton East—Stoney Creek** by-election!

Mark your X on or before
September 3 to elect your
Member of Provincial Parliament.



What is a by-election?

A by-election is called in an electoral district between general elections to replace a Member of Provincial Parliament who has vacated their seat in the Legislative Assembly of Ontario.

Are you eligible to vote?

To vote in this by-election, you must be:

- + 18 years of age or older on election day;
- + a Canadian citizen; and
- + a resident of Hamilton East—Stoney Creek.

Elections Ontario app



Download the app to register and access:

- + a digital voter information card that can be scanned when you go to vote;
- + a list of candidates, with an audio feature;
- + local election office and voting location information; and
- + customizable notifications.

Register to Vote

Check, update or add your information to the voters list on our app or website by **August 24** to receive a voter information card in the mail.

You can still vote if you do not have a voter information card. Bring one piece of ID showing both your name and home address when you go to vote.

ID to vote

Do you have a voter information card?

- ✓ **YES** — bring your voter information card and one piece of ID showing your name (e.g. utility bill)
 - ⊘ **NO** — bring one piece of ID showing your name **and** home address (e.g. Ontario driver's licence)
- + Find a list of accepted ID on our app or website.

Vote early



At your local election office

- + Vote in person from **August 6** until 6 PM on **September 2**.



By mail

- + Apply to vote by mail on our website.
- + Elections Ontario must receive your application by 6 PM on **August 28** and your completed voting kit by 6 PM on **September 3** to be counted.



During advance voting

- + Vote at any advance voting location in your electoral district from 10 AM to 8 PM **August 26 to 28**.

Vote on election day



Vote at your assigned voting location from 9 AM to 9 PM on **September 3**.

- + Find your assigned voting location on your voter information card, or on our app or website.
- + If your assigned voting location is not accessible, contact your local election office before election day to request to be transferred to another voting location.

Come work for us!



If you're 16 or older, you can apply on our website to work as an election official. All positions are paid and training is provided.

Accessibility



You can use assistive voting technology at your local election office from **August 26 to September 2** or by appointment on election day.
