

Campaign Expense Spending Limit by Electoral District for the 2018 General Election

The total campaign expenses incurred by a registered candidate's campaign, its registered constituency association, and anyone acting on behalf of the candidate's campaign or constituency association during a campaign period must not exceed the amount determined by multiplying an indexed amount currently at \$1.30 by the number of electors in the candidate's electoral district.

In order to determine the limit on campaign expenses, the number of electors is defined as the greatest of:

- the number of electors shown in the preliminary list of electors provided to candidates; and
- the number of electors entitled to vote as determined by the CEO after polling day.

* For registered candidates in the electoral districts of: Algoma-Manitoulin, Kenora-Rainy River, Kiiwetinoong, Mushkegowuk-James Bay, Nickel Belt, Thunder Bay-Atikokan, Thunder Bay-Superior North, and Timiskaming-Cochrane, the amount of the joint campaign expense limit is increased by an indexed amount. The indexed amount is amended every five years and is currently \$9,478.
